LOCAL EMPLOYERS RECOGNIZED AT HEALTHY WORKPLACE AWARDS CEREMONY

FREDERICK, MD -- The annual Healthy Workplace Recognition Awards Ceremony was held Thursday, June 11, 2015 at Dutch's Daughter to recognize Frederick County workplaces that are committed to improving employee health and well-being. This year, 20 Frederick County workplaces were honored. The Healthy Workplace Recognition Program is a partnership between [Frederick Regional Health System](#), the [Frederick County Health Department](#), and the [Frederick County Chamber of Commerce](#).

All applicants for the Healthy Workplace Recognition Program completed the CDC Worksite Health Scorecard. The Scorecard is a tool that helps employers assess whether they have implemented evidence-based health strategies in their workplace to prevent heart disease, stroke and related conditions such as hypertension, diabetes, and obesity. Minimum score requirements are scaled for each recognition level according to employer size. There are four levels for which worksites can become recognized: On the Path, Bronze, Silver, and Gold. Higher levels of recognition require employers to meet additional criteria, such as having a worksite wellness champion or team, completion of a minimum number of worksite health improvement goals, and demonstration that plan outcomes are tracked and evaluated.

All award recipients received a plaque. In addition, one monetary award was given to the top scoring application within each employer category (very small, small, medium, and large). Each of the top scoring applicant winners presented their successful worksite wellness strategies and outcomes at the awards event.
