COVID-19 Boosters Authorized for Children 5-11 Years Old

FREDERICK, MD -- The [Food and Drug Administration \(FDA\)](#) has authorized and the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#) now recommends that children 5 through 11 years **should** receive a COVID-19 booster shot 5 months after their second dose of Pfizer vaccine.

Frederick County Health Department vaccination clinics will begin offering Pfizer boosters to children 5-11 years old on Friday, May 20, 2022. Upcoming COVID-19 vaccination clinics are posted on [our website](#), and clinics offering vaccine for children 5-11 years old are specified with a link for that age group. Please schedule an appointment to guarantee a vaccination.

CDC is also strengthening its recommendation that those 12 and older who are immunocompromised and those 50 and older **should** receive a second booster dose at least 4 months after their first.
