1. Introductions

6. Subcommittee Report Out

- a. *Responsible Gun Ownership*: Dr. Rachel Mandel provided the report out. The group is seeking props to support the re-shoot of several scenes from the PSA. The subcommittee has plans to include ERPO information in the longer version of the PSA. The subcommittee is reaching out to Bill Kelly to coordinate distribution of a brochure Mr. Kelly has access to.

Ms. Shapiro reported that members of the subcommittee are meeting with Living Works next week to learn more about their program and how people access it. Idea discussed for a coupon to allow community access. Ms. Shapiro also reported outreach was occurring to the FNP and Frederick Scanner regarding guidance to include 988 info in their posts and communication about suicide, and information about stigmatizing language.
