**Update on COVID-19 Vaccine:**

*Current Phase:* We are currently working on vaccinating people in Phase 1A, which includes health care workers, long term care residents and staff, and first responders. As of today, over half of the nursing homes in the county have been offered vaccine, and more are scheduled next week. Nursing home and assisted living facilities are being vaccinated by CVS and Walgreens. Next week, the health department's clinics will also start vaccinating workers in Urgent Care and Dialysis facilities.
