Frederick County to Follow Maryland Vaccine Eligibility Timeline

Frederick, Md. – Frederick County Health Department (FCHD) announced today that they will be following the [Maryland timeline](#) for COVID-19 vaccine distribution, depending on vaccine availability. FCHD is still scheduled to receive 1,800 doses per week. FCHD will send out messages by email, text, and phone message to people who have completed the Vaccine Interest Form.

Starting today, FCHD will begin scheduling Frederick County residents who are 65 years and older.

Starting Monday, FCHD will begin scheduling everyone in Phase 1A, 1B and 1C.

Frederick County residents in 2A (people who are 60 years and older) will be eligible starting March 23 depending on vaccine availability.

Phase	Who	When
2A	All Marylanders age 60 and older.	March 23
2B	Marylanders age 16 and older with underlying medical conditions that increase the risk for severe COVID-19 illness.	March 30
2C	All Marylanders age 55 and older, as well as essential workers in critical industries, including construction workers, food services, utilities, transportation, financial services, IT and other infrastructure.	April 13
3	General population, including healthy adults age 16 and older.	April 27
