Frederick County Moves to State Pre-registration System for COVID-19 Vaccinations

Frederick, Md., April 15, 2021 – Frederick County Health Department (FCHD) announced today that they will be changing the process to register for a COVID-19 vaccination. Individuals who are 16 years and older can pre-register for the COVID-19 vaccine at the Maryland statewide pre-registration system <https://onestop.md.gov/preregistration>.

This change will allow people to go to one website to sign up for an appointment from the Frederick County Health Department and other vaccine sites that are state operated or state supported. FCHD will continue sending appointment invitations to individuals who previously completed the Frederick County Vaccine Interest Form until everyone on that list has been offered an appointment. Individuals who register through the state system will also be sent appointment invitations to FCHD vaccination clinics.

Appointments are still required at Frederick County Health Department COVID-19 vaccination clinics. Maryland and Frederick County are in Phase 3 of COVID-19 vaccine distribution and all Marylanders 16 years and older are eligible to receive the vaccine.
