COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics Moving to Health Department

FREDERICK, MD – After almost two years of mass vaccination clinics in multiple locations, the Frederick County Health Department (FCHD) is now moving their primary COVID-19 vaccination clinic to their main location at 350 Montevue Lane.

The last clinic at the Himes Avenue location was held on Friday, October 14. The Himes Avenue location was the most recent mass vaccination clinic location run by FCHD. Previous large clinic locations included Scott Key Center, Butterfly Ridge Elementary School, Frederick Community College, and Frederick Health Village.

FCHD would like to thank the community partners who made these mass vaccination locations possible: Frederick County Government, Frederick County Public Schools, Frederick Community College, and Frederick Health. Mass vaccination clinics were a critical component of the county's COVID-19 response and enabled the health department to administer 139,291 vaccinations.

With this location change, FCHD will focus on offering COVID-19 vaccinations for young children 6 months to 5 years and updated bivalent boosters. FCHD will continue holding COVID-19 vaccination clinics at Frederick County Public Library locations in Brunswick, Myersville, Thurmont and Walkersville, as well as at the Frederick County Health Department. Appointments are required to reduce wait times.
