COVID-19 Vaccine for Older and Immunocompromised Adults

FREDERICK, MD – The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) [has authorized](#) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) [now recommends](#) an additional COVID-19 bivalent vaccine dose for adults ages 65 years and older and additional doses for people who are immunocompromised. Individuals ages 6 years and older who have already received an updated bivalent COVID-19 vaccine (or booster) do not need to take any action unless they are 65 years or older or immunocompromised.

The Frederick County Health Department (FCHD) will be holding their next COVID-19 vaccine clinic on Saturday, April 29 at 350 Montevue Lane in Frederick, MD. Go to FrederickCountyMD.gov/CovidVaccine to schedule an appointment. Appointments are required.

COVID-19 vaccines are free and insurance is not required. Please do not come more than 15 minutes before your appointment to help us avoid long lines. Please do not come to a vaccination clinic if you have any symptoms, or if you are waiting for COVID-19 test results.
