COVID-19 Vaccinations Now Open to People 75 Years and Older

Frederick, MD – January 14, 2021

Governor Hogan just announced that COVID-19 Vaccination is now open to group 1A and people 75 years and older for the remainder of this week. (Please note, this is not all of 1B.)

- To make an appointment, please go to FrederickCountyMD.gov/CovidVaccine. Please use Chrome to register instead of Internet Explorer.
- If you need help making your appointment, we will be opening a call center soon and will send out more information when it is available.
- If you have friends, neighbors, or family members who are in this group who need help making their appointment, please help them to make it online. Vaccine is still limited, but we will add more appointment dates throughout the week. Please check back if appointments are full.

Next week, Governor Hogan announced that COVID-19 vaccination will be open to group 1A and all of group 1B.

Governor Hogan also announced that COVID-19 vaccination will be open to people in group 1C starting January 25.

Please be aware that our vaccination clinics are by appointment only. We cannot accept walk-ins.
