Children 12-15 Years Eligible for COVID-19 Vaccinations

Frederick, MD – Children 12-15 years old are eligible for COVID-19 vaccinations with the Pfizer vaccine starting Thursday, May 13 at Frederick County Health Department vaccination clinics. Appointments are available this week, and both Pfizer (for people 12 years and older) and Moderna (for people 18 years and older) are available at the Oak Street clinic ([directions](#)). Regular clinic hours are:

- Thursday, May 13, from 4 p.m.- 7 p.m.: [Pfizer 12+](#), [Moderna 18+](#)
- Friday, May 14, from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m.: [Pfizer 12+](#), [Moderna 18+](#)

Schedule an appointment by clicking a link above or by calling 301-600-7900 Monday – Friday, 8 a.m.- 5 p.m., or call 301-600-7905 for Spanish.

Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to be vaccinated.

Walk-ins will be taken in these clinics as vaccine supply allows. Walk-in lines may take longer and a vaccination is not guaranteed.
