COVID-19 Boosters Authorized for Teens 16-17 Years Old

FREDERICK, MD -- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have given emergency use authorization for a single Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine booster for adolescents who are 16 and 17 years old. Individuals in this age group can receive a Pfizer booster if it has been six months or more since their second dose of Pfizer.

Vaccine is readily available in the community at both walk-in and appointment required clinics.

- Frederick County Health Department vaccination clinics will begin offering Pfizer boosters to teens age 16 and 17 years old today (Friday, December 10, 2021). Go to [our website](#) for upcoming health department vaccination clinics. Boosters are available at any clinic offering that vaccine type.

For help scheduling an appointment, call 855-MDGoVax or 855-634-6829 between 8am and 8pm, seven days a week.

Important note! Booster doses can be obtained from any vaccination clinic. It is not necessary to return to the same vaccination clinic where first and second doses were received to get a booster.
