COVID-19 Boosters Authorized for Children 12-15 Years Old

FREDERICK, MD -- Following the latest action from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the State of Maryland is now able to provide COVID-19 booster shots for children between the ages of 12 and 15 years.

Frederick County Health Department vaccination clinics will begin offering Pfizer boosters to children 12-15 years old on Wednesday, January 5, 2022. Upcoming clinics are posted on [our website](#) for upcoming health department vaccination clinics. Boosters are available at all vaccination clinics. Scheduling an appointment is the best way to guarantee a vaccination, but some walk-ins will be taken as supply allows.

All Marylanders age 12 and older are now eligible for a COVID-19 booster five months after completing their second dose of the Pfizer vaccine. This is a change from previous guidance for Pfizer boosters to be administered at least six months after a second dose of Pfizer.

Individuals 18 years and older who received two doses of Moderna vaccine are still eligible for a booster 6 months after their second vaccination. Individuals 18 years and older who received a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine are still eligible for a booster dose 2 months after their single dose.
