Cancer Prevention Program/Performance Measure Updates:

Dr. Brookmyer, Local Health Improvement priority setting meetings are scheduled throughout the community and September 13th is the final session. It is an all-day session for voting on the priorities for the Local Health Improvement Plan. One is scheduled Saturday, July 30 in Walkersville. Evening sessions next week will be in Myersville, Urbana, Mt. Airy' and New Market. The Local Health Improvement Plan work groups end up being formed by what the priorities are. At meetings data is reviewed, such as the Community Health Assessment, so that everyone attending has knowledge of health indicators. There is a process of voting for the priorities and currently these areas are Behavioral Health, Dental, Frail and Vulnerable Seniors, and Chronic Disease Education. Out of the last 3 smaller meetings someone brought up the issue of non-medical support for cancer patients' caregivers. As this is not a top priority, the Cancer Coalition may want to consider addressing need. A suggestion to develop a resource book came up. During discussion Coalition members concluded that the support needs of cancer patients and their caregivers may have similarities to those for the frail and vulnerable seniors. It was suggested that the Coalition address the development of a resource book as a possible future project. This may begin by Coalition members taking notes between meetings on existing resources as well as gaps in services.

Clinical Updates:

- Reviewed each report of BCCP & CRC (See enclosed reports)
- No breast or cervical cancer diagnosed in BCCP
- 1 patient diagnosed with colorectal cancer in CRC
- Exceeded goals for number of colonoscopies performed
- Many thought to be navigating clients ended up being clinical clients as their insurance did not cover the entire cost of colonoscopies. Most navigating clients have MA

- New Cancer Center at Rosehill location in process of being built and slated for completion next year
- All cancer services from 7th street will move there. Crestwood services to stay where they are as their emphasis is Women's Health. Radiation, Medical Oncology, and the Center for Chest Disease, and the Urology Center will relocate to the new Cancer Center with physicians' offices on 3rd floor. Will be very holistic.

Member/Community Updates:

- Maggie
 - Wants to disseminate Breast Cancer Symposium information to every coalition member and will contact Beth Mowrey as symposium is October 19, before Coalition's next meeting.
 - Breast Cancer Walk - Maggie and Lori on committee for Pink Ribbon 5K Run/Walk October 1st. Great event (see flyers)
 - Keys Cancer Awareness Night held August 12th @ 6pm
 - They are part of 80/20 and looking into it and very interested
- Katie organizes Tobacco Cessation programs at FCHD and is hoping to have information at next Coalition meeting regarding the goal to bring Tobacco Cessation services out into the community for residents unable to access the program at the FCHD.

- Kelly
Completed Coaching program. Her focus is working with cancer patients who are newly diagnosed and their families. Kelly would like to build a supportive network with coalition members
- Janet from FCAA noted partnering with FCHD to focus on chronic disease management for their patients. Very excited.
- Roseann
 - In addition to the current chronic disease management grant in which we are partnering with FCAA & Dr. Kazmi's practice, the Preventive Health Program also started a chronic disease management in-house program, "I'm living Healthy." It is currently being offered to our cancer screening clients who are diagnosed with diabetes and/or hypertension. The program offers health coaching by the staff nurses.
 - The Preventive Health Program applied for a Diabetes Prevention Program grant, a more structured year-long program. If the grant is awarded, we will hire a lifestyle coach to administer the program.
 - Colorectal and Breast & Cervical Cancer programs are doing a pilot program that will work on ways to integrate both programs.
- Discussed collaboration with FRHS. FCHD & FRHS are meeting monthly as a Chronic Disease Management Team in an effort to support wellness and decrease epidemic Chronic diseases such as obesity, diabetes
- Gloria (FCHD) sees an increase in the prenatal clinic of obese children in the Hispanic community. She also notes that some families believe being overweight demonstrates that their children are well-nourished. Discussed a community need and effort to change perceptions.
