- buckets
- cans
- bottles
- toys, particularly plastic
- jars and their lids
- swimming or wading pools
- tires
- wheelbarrows
- wagons
- bird baths
- cups
- flower pots & saucers
- blocked gutters
- plastic drain pipe
- tree holes and root holes
- pet water bowls
- trash cans without lids
- trash can lids left upside down
- flat roofs
- boats & canoes
- unused hot tubs
- rain barrels
- tarps over wood piles or equipment
- air conditioner drain areas
- ceramic bowls/old toilet bowls & tubs
- pipes in ground (upright)

Most of our mosquito complaints during the summer months in urban or suburban areas are caused by mosquitoes coming from the above artificial and natural container sites. Use the “TIP OR TOSS” method to dispose of the standing water and/or the containers themselves.

**\*\*\*REMEMBER, only the homeowner can control these mosquitoes!**
