
Screening Saves Lives!

Why is screening so important?

Yearly breast exams, mammograms, and regular Pap tests help to find breast and cervical problems early. When problems are found early, they can be treated more easily, adding years to your life.

What if there is a problem?

If you need follow-up breast or cervical tests, staff will explain what is needed and can help pay for the cost of the extra tests.



Clinical Breast Exam, done before your mammogram, is a simple test done in doctor's office.

Who can receive these services at no cost?



No cost screening is available for Frederick County women

- ages 40-64
- not insured or have insurance that does not cover breast or cervical cancer screening
- have a limited income



What can I do?

- Have a mammogram and clinical breast exam every year.
- Have a Pap test regularly.
