Things We Can All Do Now

Reach Out

Call a nursing home in your city or town. Ask how you can help, including providing staff support.

Senior Centers

Call the senior center or Council on Aging in your city or town. See if they need help with meal delivery, outreach to isolated older people, care partner support, or other services.

Boards of Health

Call your local Board of Health. Ask when their next meeting is and if you can join by phone or video. Offer to do outreach calls, connect with nursing homes or assisted living residences.

State DPH

Visit your state's Department of Public Health website. See if there is a portal to sign up to volunteer, or a portal to apply for job openings in nursing homes or assisted living residences.
