### Frederick County Agency Updates for May 20, 2020

#### Health Department:

The Health Department is now reporting that 1581 (+50 in 24hrs) residents have tested positive for COVID-19, 96 (+3 in 24hrs) people have died, and 874 (+81 in 24hrs) people have been released from isolation. #### City of Frederick:

On March 13th, Mayor O'Connor declared a City State of Emergency. As part of that declaration, all due dates for City bills, permits, licensures, and citations will be extended to thirty days after the State of the Emergency ends. If you would like to pay bills or citations at this time, please note that City facilities are closed to the public. Payments can be made online or via drop boxes at the appropriate City location.
