### Frederick County Agency Updates for June 1, 2020

Frederick, MD – June 1, 2020

#### Health Department:

The Health Department is now reporting that 1961 (+22 in 24hrs) residents have tested positive for COVID-19, 108 (+0 in 24hrs) people have died, and 1274 (+40 in 24hrs) people have been released from isolation. For more statistics, please visit <http://FrederickCountyMD.gov/COVIDstats>.

#### Positivity Rate

Last week, Maryland started reporting the positivity rate, which is the percent of people who have tested positive for COVID-19 out of everyone who has been tested. Maryland and Frederick County have seen this rate decrease in the last several weeks. This metric has been added to our dashboard and will be showing the 7 day average going forward. Today's 7-day average positivity rate for Frederick County is 8.5%, which is lower than the Maryland rate of 10.7%.

#### JIC:

Frederick County is in Stage 1 of Recovery along with most of Maryland. Governor Hogan has determined which businesses can be open at this time. County Executive Gardner can be more restrictive, but not less restrictive than the Governor; she cannot open things he has not opened yet.

#### Frequently Asked Question

*Since hair salons and barbers are open, can my nail salon be open, too?*

Nail salons are not part of the services permitted by the Governor in Stage 1.

## Phase I: COVID-19 Reopening Recovery

The listing below of **OPEN** and **CLOSED** establishments in Frederick County, MD, are in accordance with Maryland Governor Hogan's Executive Orders 20-05-13-01 and 20-05-27-01. As reopening begins, continue to:

- Wash hands often
- Physically distance 6 ft. apart
- Wear a face covering
- Keep gatherings to 10 people or less
- Stay home when sick
- Get tested if needed
