### Frederick County Agency Updates for June 10, 2020

Frederick, MD – June 10, 2020

#### **Health Department:**

Frederick County Health Department (FCHD) will now be reporting COVID-19 statistics based on numbers from Maryland Department of Health (MDH). MDH reports deaths after COVID-19 has been confirmed as a cause of death, so there will be a decrease from what FCHD has been reporting since cause of death can take time to determine. FCHD will not be reporting the number of people released from isolation for several more days as the data is not currently available during the transition to the state's contact tracing system.

The Health Department is now reporting that 2178 (+26 in 24hrs) residents have tested positive for COVID-19 and 105 (+1 in 24hrs) people have confirmed COVID-19 as cause of death. For more statistics, please visit <http://FrederickCountyMD.gov/COVIDstats>.

#### **Frederick Health Hospital:**


