Health Department:

The Health Department is now reporting that 2,441 (+16 in 24hrs) residents have tested positive for COVID-19 and 109 (+0 in 24hrs) people have confirmed COVID-19 as cause of death. For more statistics, please visit <http://FrederickCountyMD.gov/COVIDstats>.



Positivity Rates


As we hear of other states experiencing increases in cases, we're watching our local metrics closely. One of the things we're keeping an eye on is the positivity rate, which is the % of tests for COVID-19 that are positive out of all the tests done. Our highest positivity rate was on April 15, when 27.4% of all tests were positive. Because of the stay-at-home order, physical distancing, and face coverings, we've seen a continued decrease in the positivity rate as testing increased and testing criteria changed to allow people with no symptoms to be tested. Our lowest rate was on June 22 at 3.9%, and since then it's been slowly increasing. The graph below is taken from our health.frederickcountymd.gov/coronavirus website and shows the positivity rates in June, including the recent increase.
