Frederick County Health Department:

The Health Department is now reporting that 2,486 (+15 in 24hrs) residents have tested positive for COVID-19 and 110 (+0 in 24hrs) people have confirmed COVID-19 as cause of death. For more statistics, please visit <http://FrederickCountyMD.gov/COVIDstats>.

The Frederick County Health Department testing clinics are open to the public with no appointment. Face coverings and physical distancing are required, but no documentation, insurance, or doctor's order is needed. Testing is FREE and you don't have to be sick to be tested. Long Term Care Facility (LTCF) Liaison (MWE# 1172012)

The LTCF Liaison will participate in weekly meetings/calls as they pertain to COVID response at the FCHD (LTCF facility call weekly, Weekly MDH updates (LTC and LHD), Planning and Tactics call); will review and report out on testing and outbreak data as it pertains to the LTC and AL Facilities; and much more. Wages: \$22.45-31.01/hr

Fiscal Accounts Technician II (MWE# 1174010)

A Fiscal Account Technician II is the full performance level of work reconciling agency accounting systems to fiscal control systems or developing automated spreadsheets, ledgers and reports or identifying budget trends and recommending budget realignments. Wages: \$16.34-20.97

Greeter (MWE# 1174017)

Will assist clients in accessing the services of the Public Health Clinic; ensure client flow in a courteous and friendly environment, and ensure those that proceed into the Public Health Clinic have the proper forms to be completed. Wages: \$15.54-19.91/hr

Collection Assistant (MWE# 1174216)

Responsible for assisting Specimen Collector position in completing collection of specimens of the public presenting to the clinic. Wages: \$15.54-19.91/hr

Registration (MWE# 1174234)

Completes registration process for those seeking testing, includes completion of lab request forms and collection of additional registration information. Wages: \$15.54-19.91/hr

Flow Monitor (MWE# 1174241)

Assists clients in accessing the services of the Public Health Test Site by ensuring client flow in a courteous and friendly environment. Wages: \$15.54-19.91/hr

Specimen Collector (MWE# 1174254)

Operates under the medical direction of the Health/Deputy Health Officer and Site Supervisor. Responsible for collection of specimens for testing from, and education of, clients presenting for testing. Wages: \$22.45-31.01/hr

Site Supervisor (MWE# 1174329)

Overall supervision of your site operations, including patient intake, assessment, flow, specimen collection and supplies as needed. Leader should have both clinical and organizational skills and understanding of purpose and function of assigned area. Wages: \$22.45-31.01/hr
