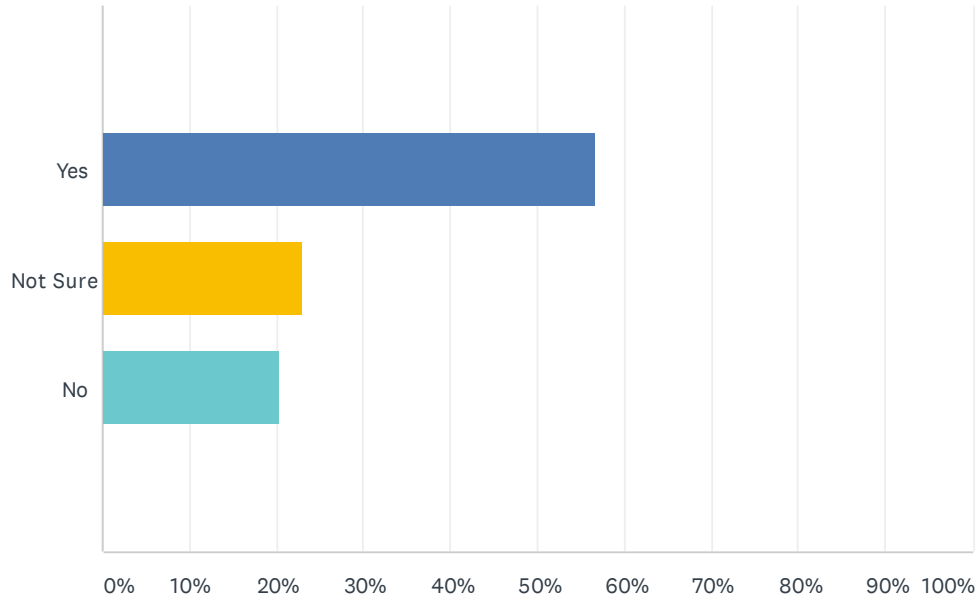


# Q1 Do you want to get a COVID-19 vaccine as soon as it becomes available to you?

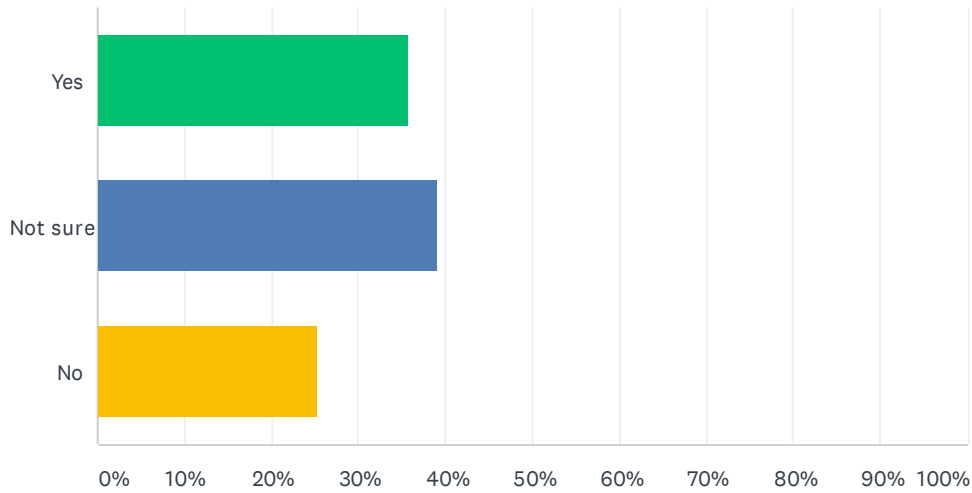

## Q2 If you are not sure, or do not want to get the COVID-19 vaccine as soon as it becomes available to you, do you think you will want to get the vaccine in the next year?

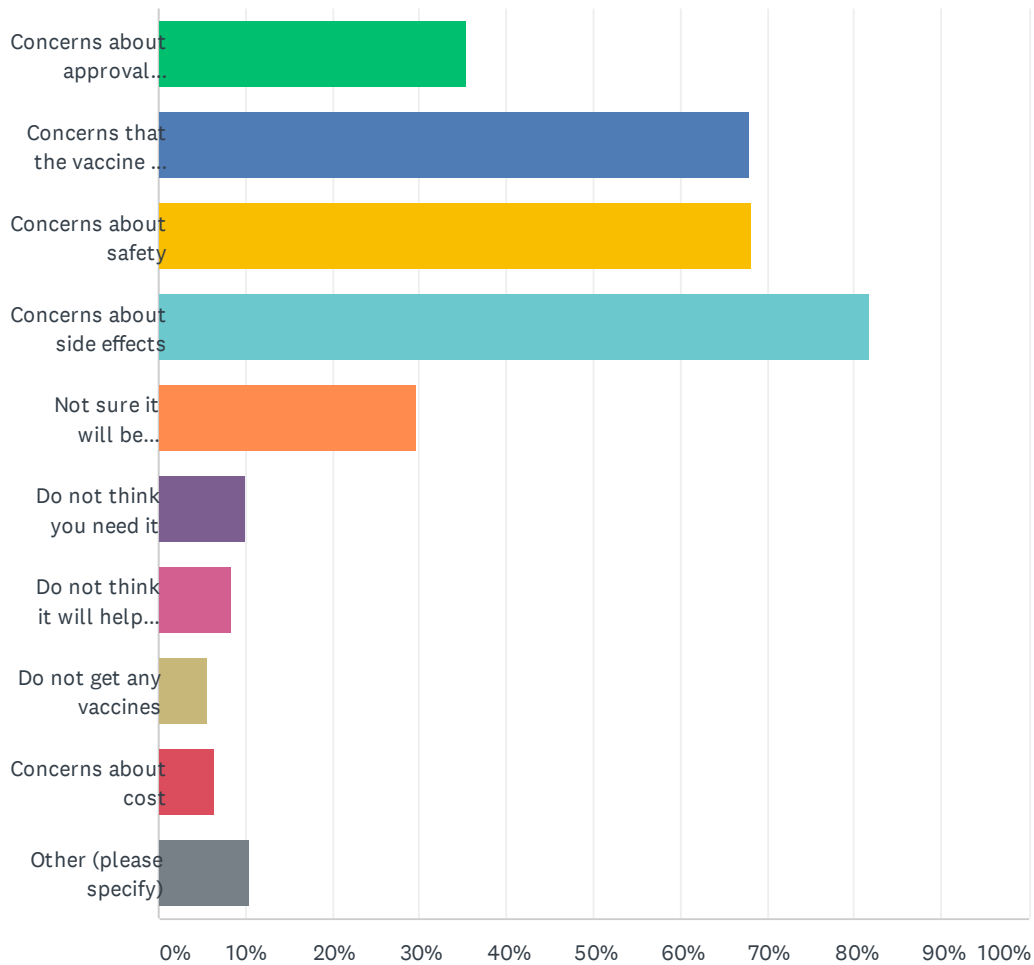

### Q3 If you are not sure or will not get the COVID-19 vaccine as soon as it become available to you, why not? Please check all that apply.

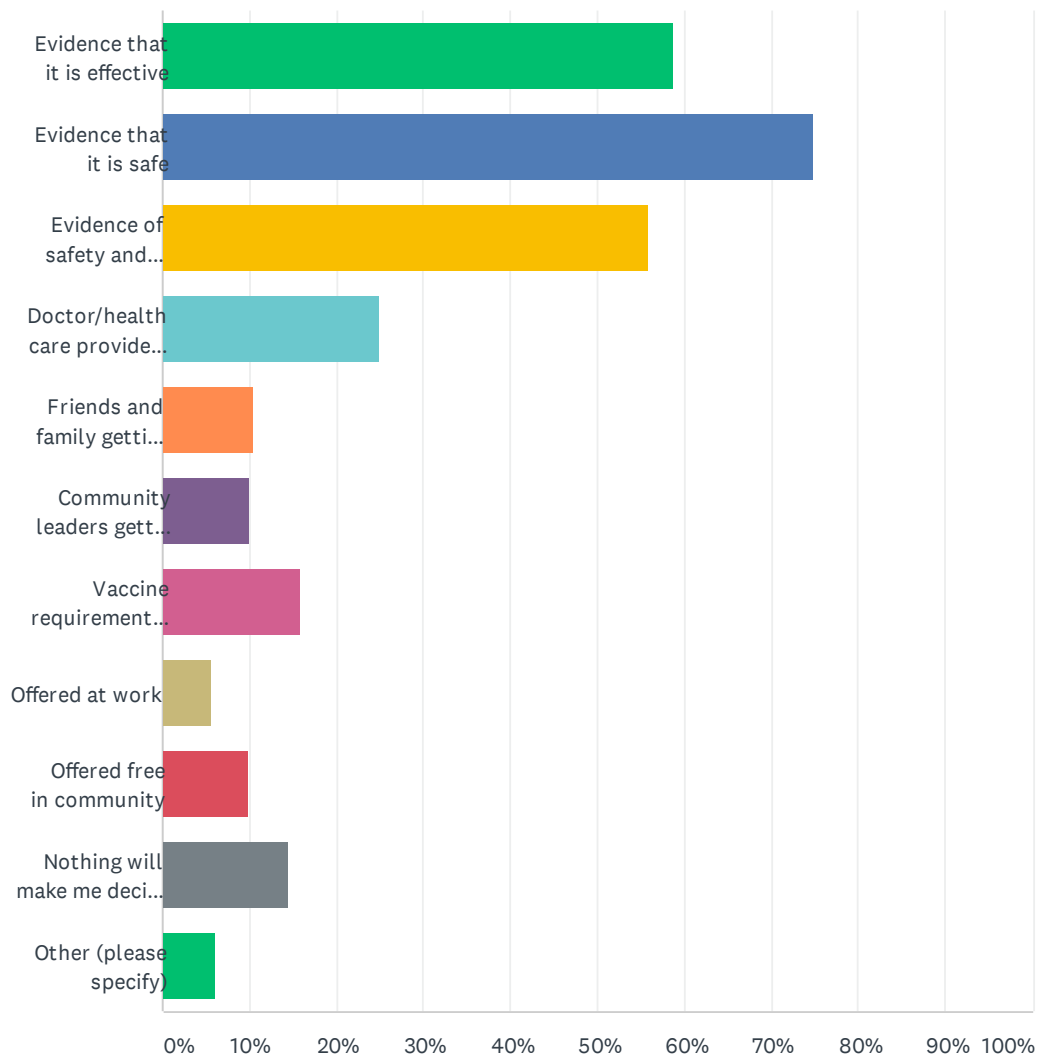

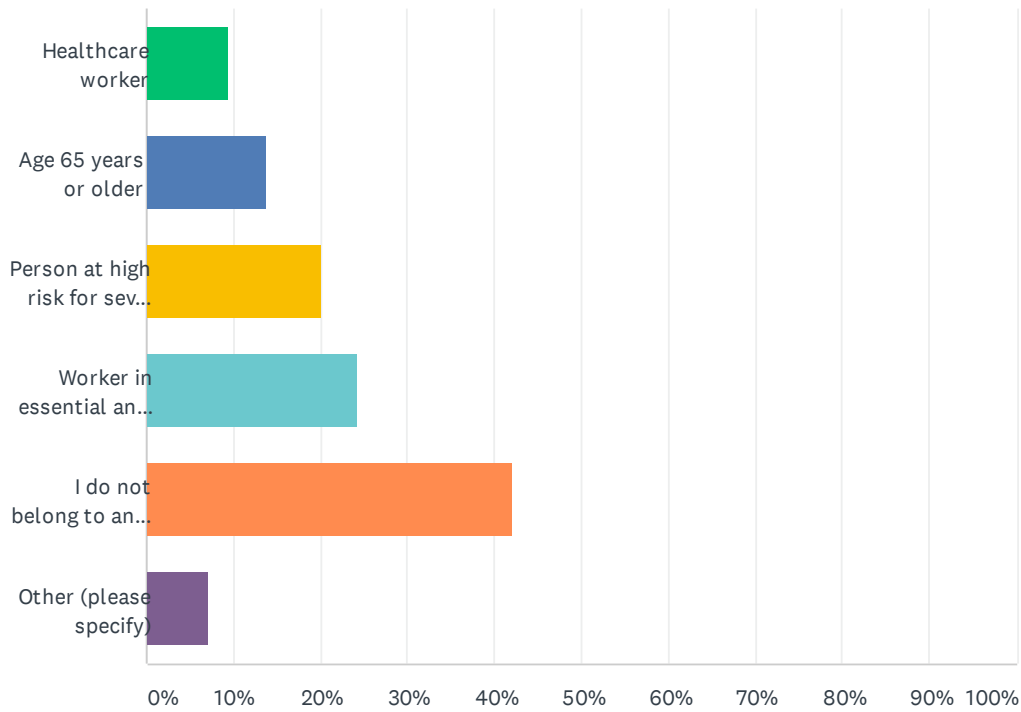

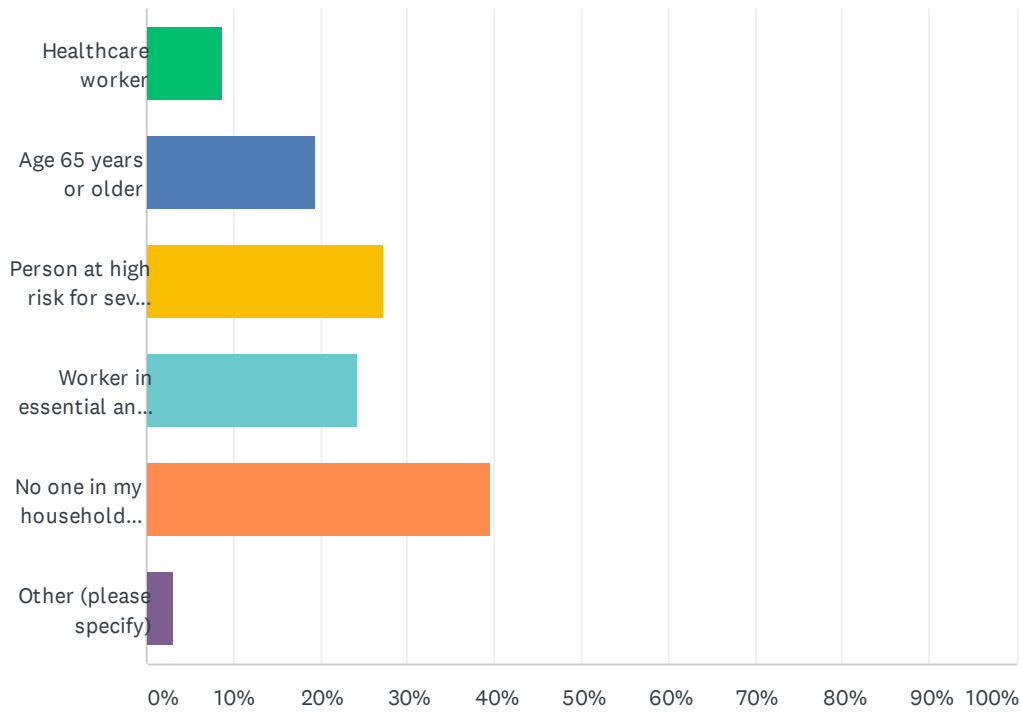

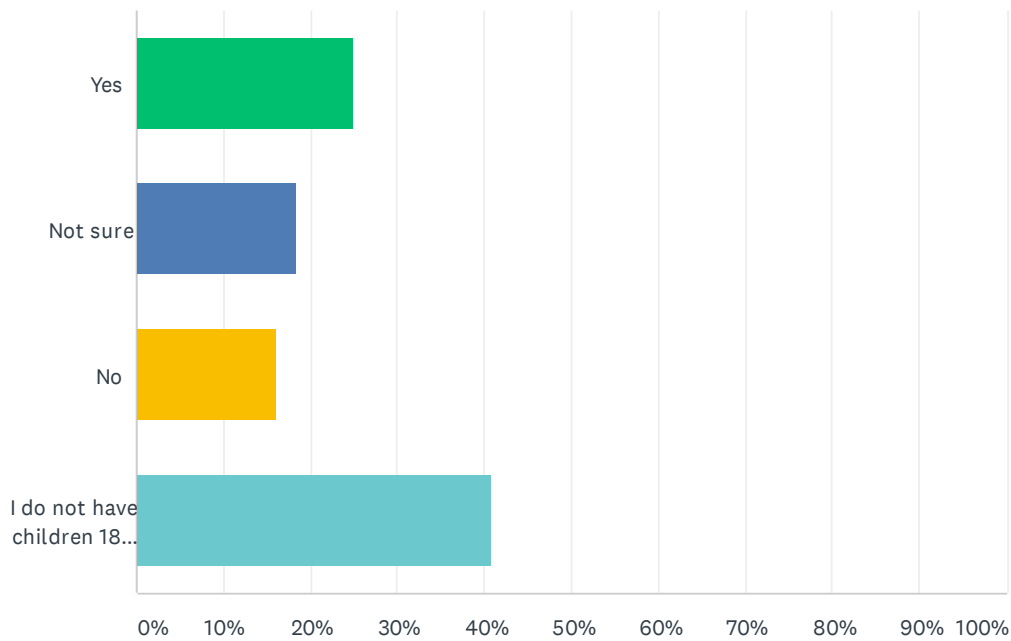

### Q7 If you have children 18 years or younger, will you get a COVID-19 vaccine for your children as soon as it becomes available?

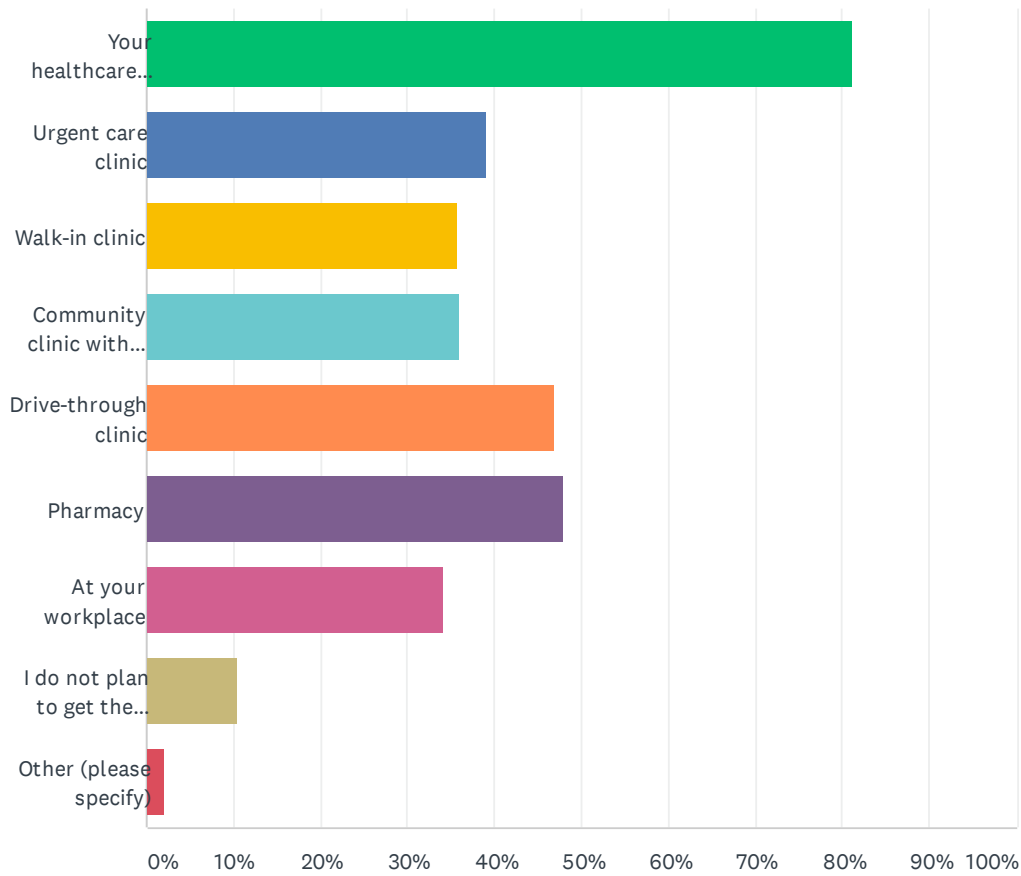

### Q8 In which locations would you be comfortable receiving the COVID-19 vaccine when you choose to do so? (choose all that apply)

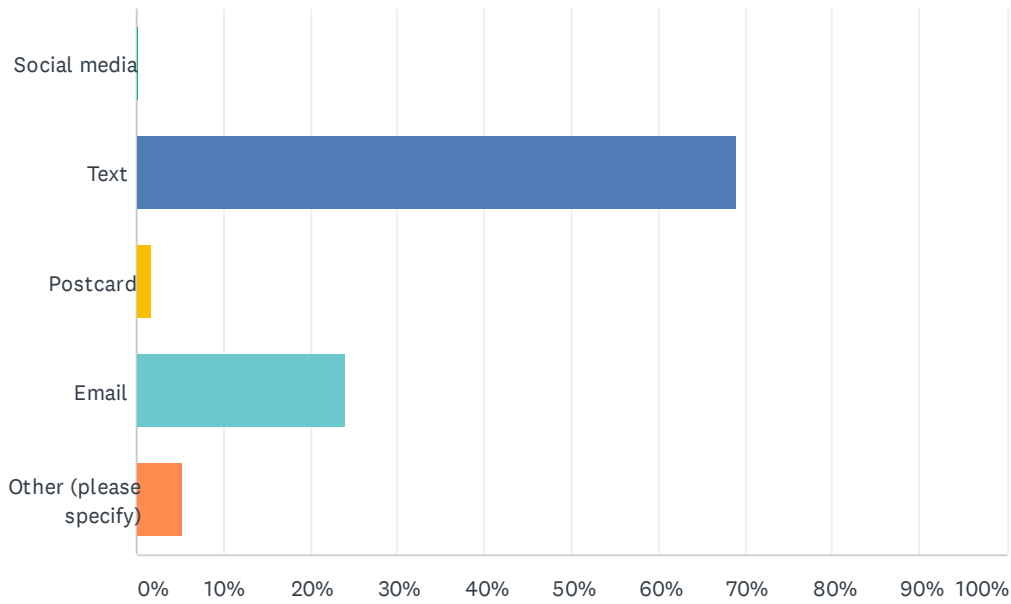

Comments provided are being used to develop public messaging. Specific answers are not shared because individuals were not asked to give permission to have their answers posted publicly, and some answers may be identifying.

Common themes and concerns included:

**Pregnant/Pregnancy/Breastfeeding (keywords) – app. 60 entries**

- Safety for mother/child
- Accurate advice
- mRNA (Pfizer/Moderna) better options than others?
- Vaccines tested on pregnant persons?

**Allergy/Allergies/Allergic (keywords) – app. 75 entries**

- Food allergy/vaccine contraindications
- Medication allergies (sulfa and otherwise)?
- Vaccine safe for people who react to flu vaccines?
- Need vaccine ingredients to determine potential reaction
- Preparation for potential reaction

**Safety/Safe (keywords) – app. 190 entries**

- No long term studies
- Concern for quickness of vaccine development
- Effectiveness of vaccine
- Long term effects of vaccine
- Vaccine interaction with preexisting medical conditions – cancer, immunodeficient, Lyme, etc.
- How long does immunity last?
- Ingredients of vaccines?

**Vaccination Locations**

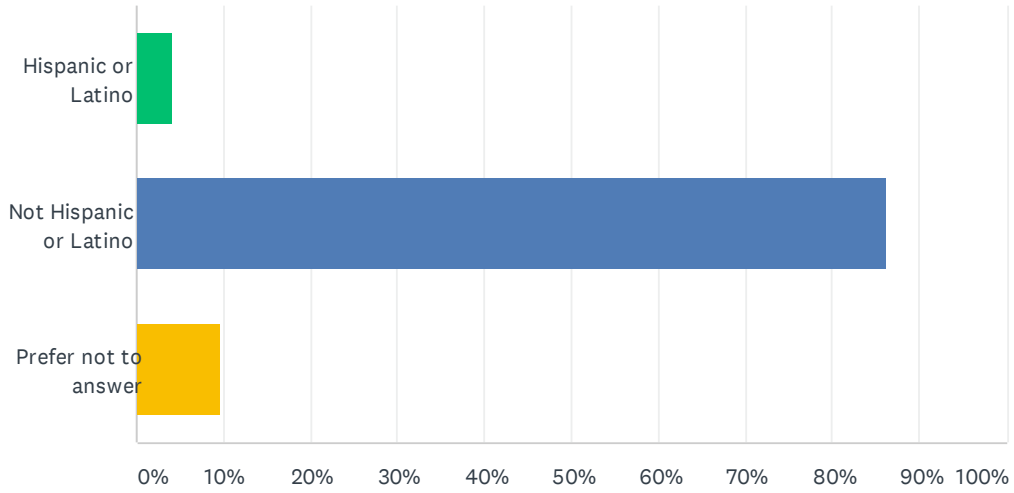

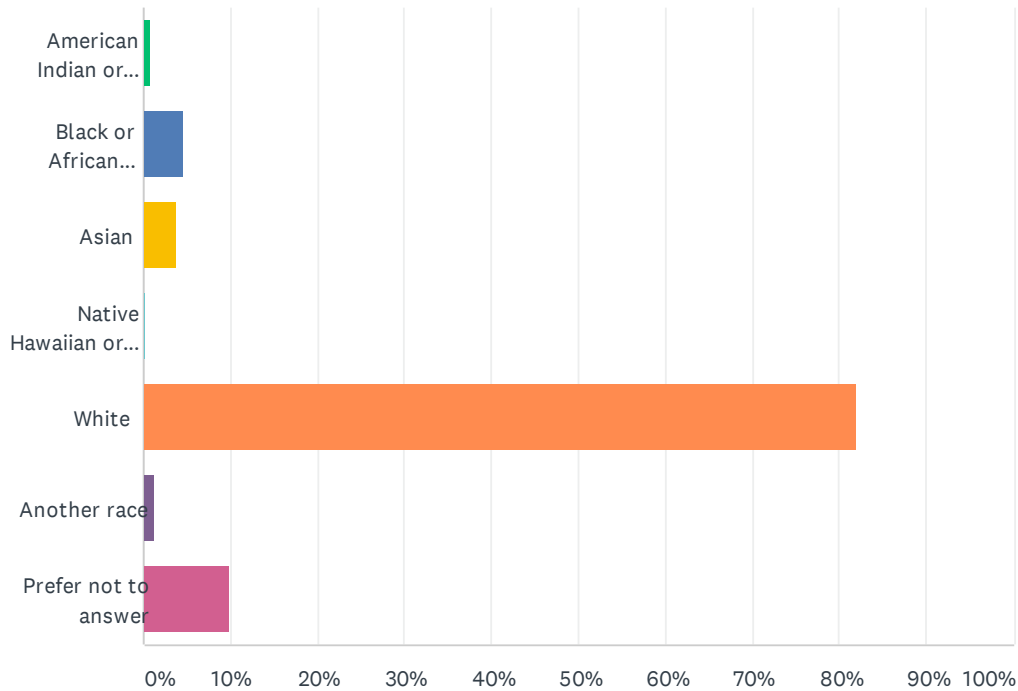

### Q12 What is your race? Please check all that apply.

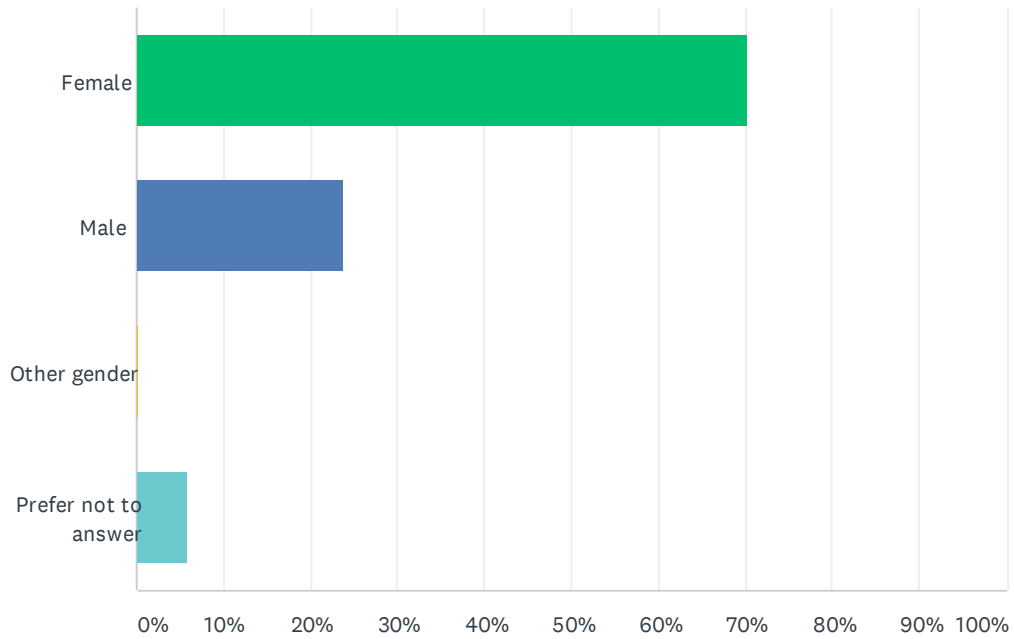

### Q13 What is your gender?

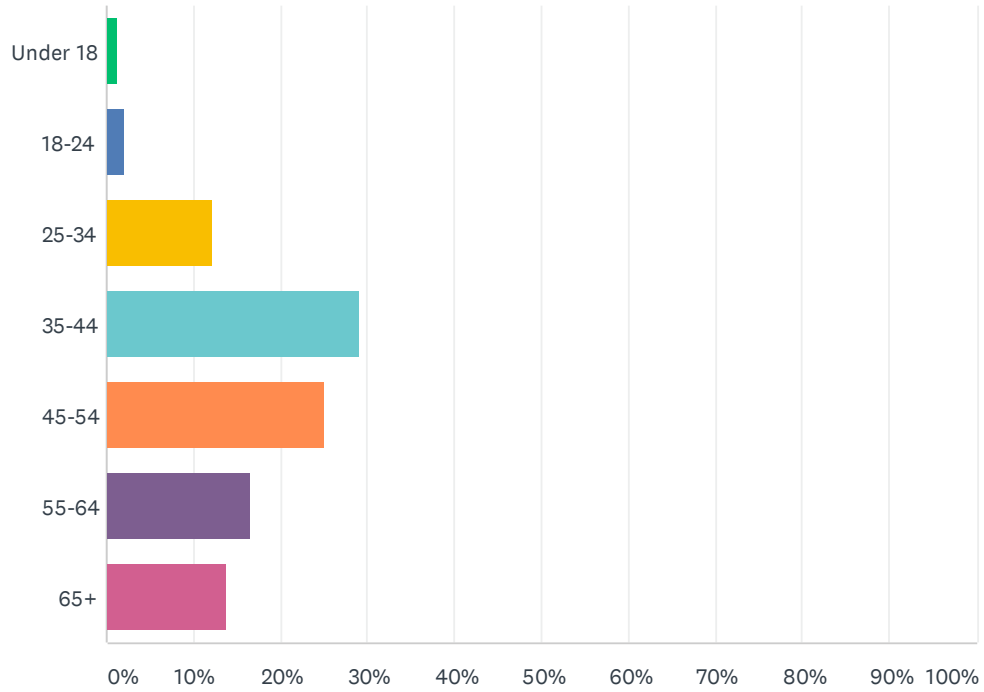

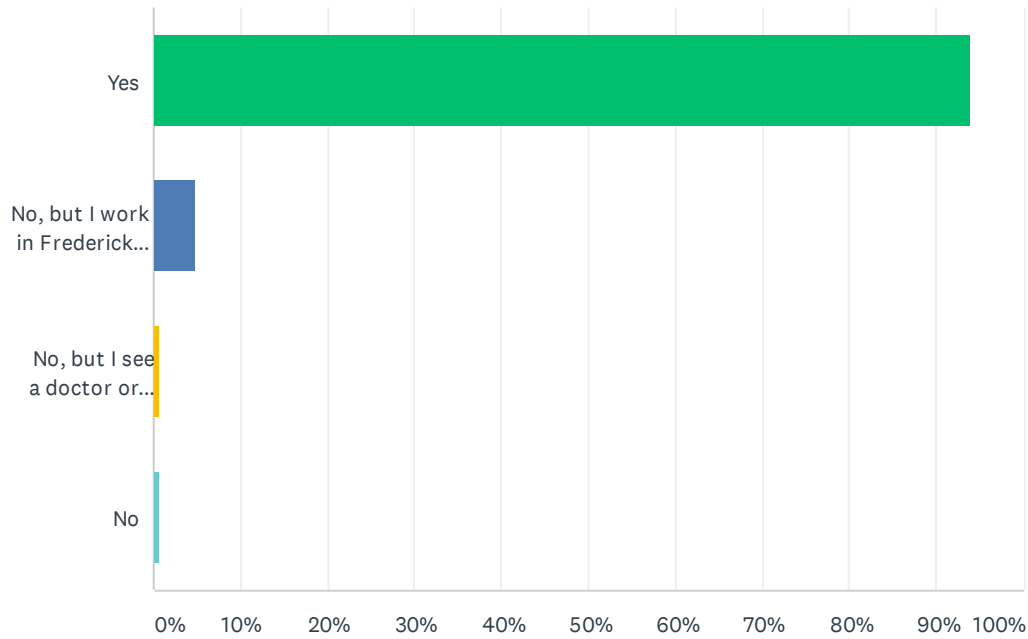
