Frederick County Board of Health Rescinds COVID-19 Regulation

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Board of Health convened on Tuesday, May 25, 2021 to hear an update on COVID-19 in Frederick County and review the health department’s COVID-19 response operations. During the meeting, [Regulation 01-2021](#) was rescinded by the Board of Health.

[Regulation 01-2021](#) had been approved by the Board of Health on March 23, 2021 and included a requirement for certain public gatherings of 100 or more persons to provide to the Health Department information about the gathering. This requirement is no longer in place.

“This change is possible thanks to our improving metrics, fewer cases and hospitalizations, and increasing vaccinations,” says Frederick County Health Officer Dr. Barbara Brookmyer. “We are excited by the progress being made in Frederick County as we’re working hard to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in or community. Vaccinations are an important part of this fight. I want to encourage everyone who hasn’t yet been vaccinated to please make an appointment or walk in to one of our clinics. It’s free, it’s easy, and it works.”
