

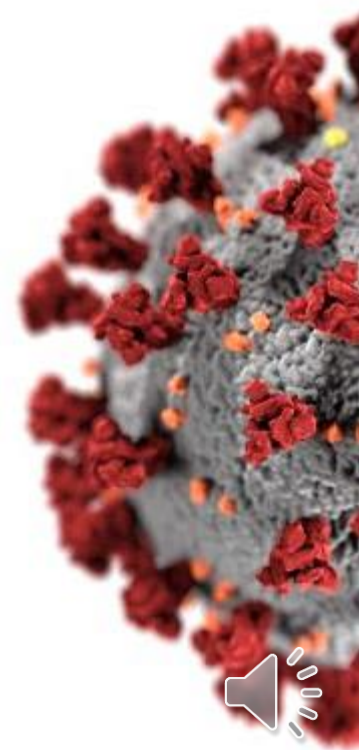

Global 7-Day Rolling Average Deaths (Apr 28, 2022)

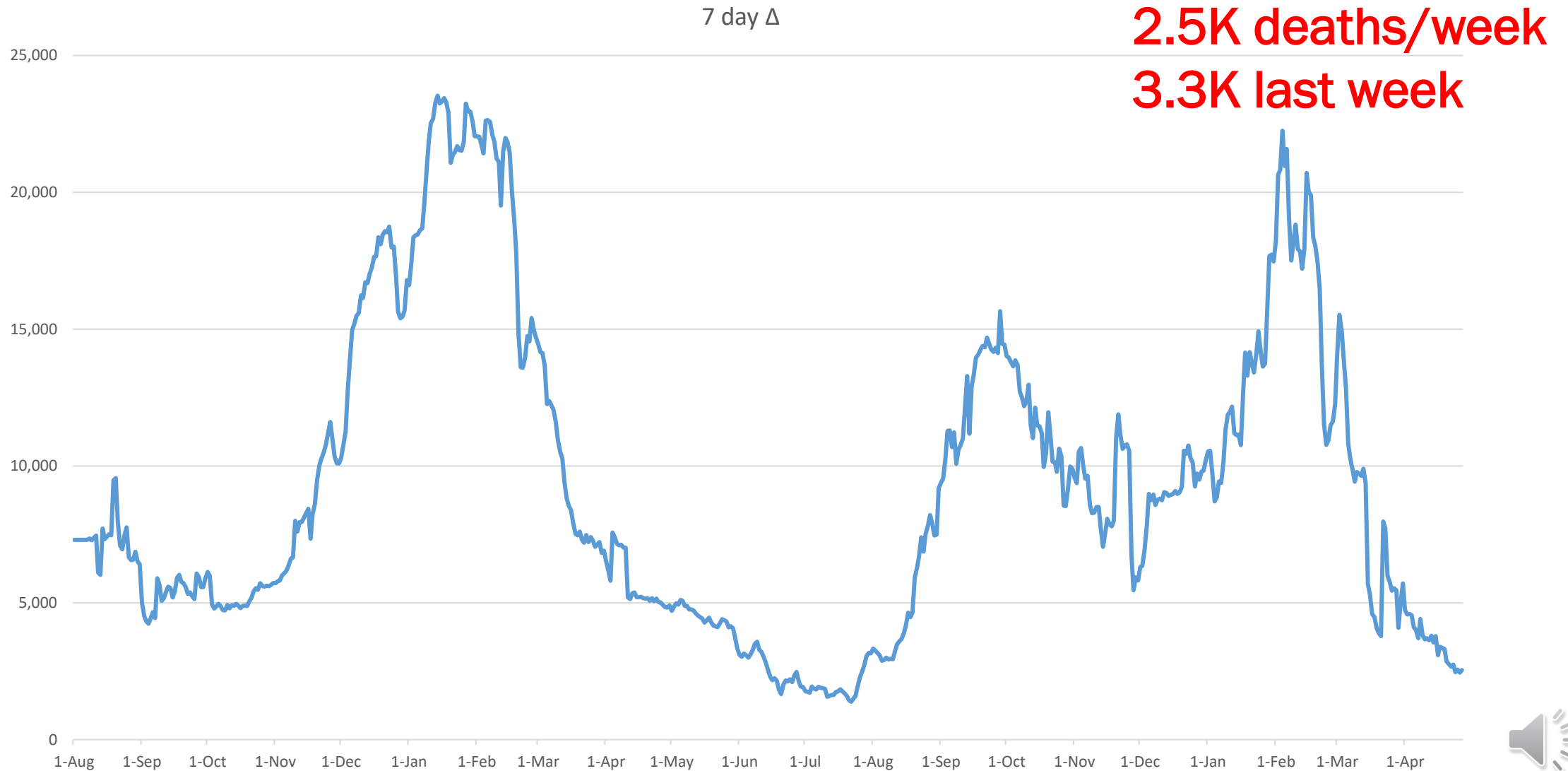

U.S. 7-Day Rolling Average Cases (Apr 28, 2022)



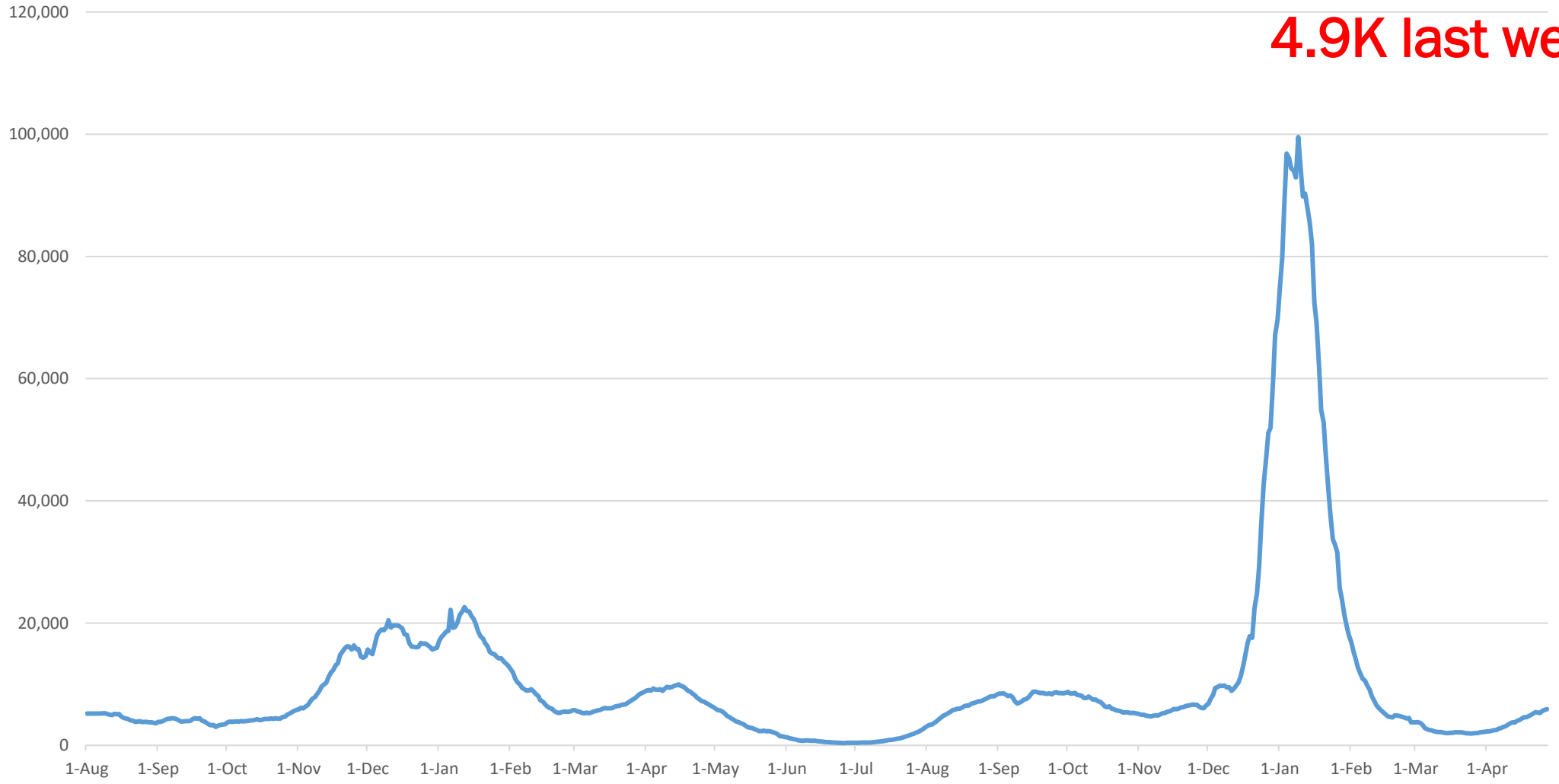

Maryland 7-Day Rolling Average Cases (Apr 28, 2022)

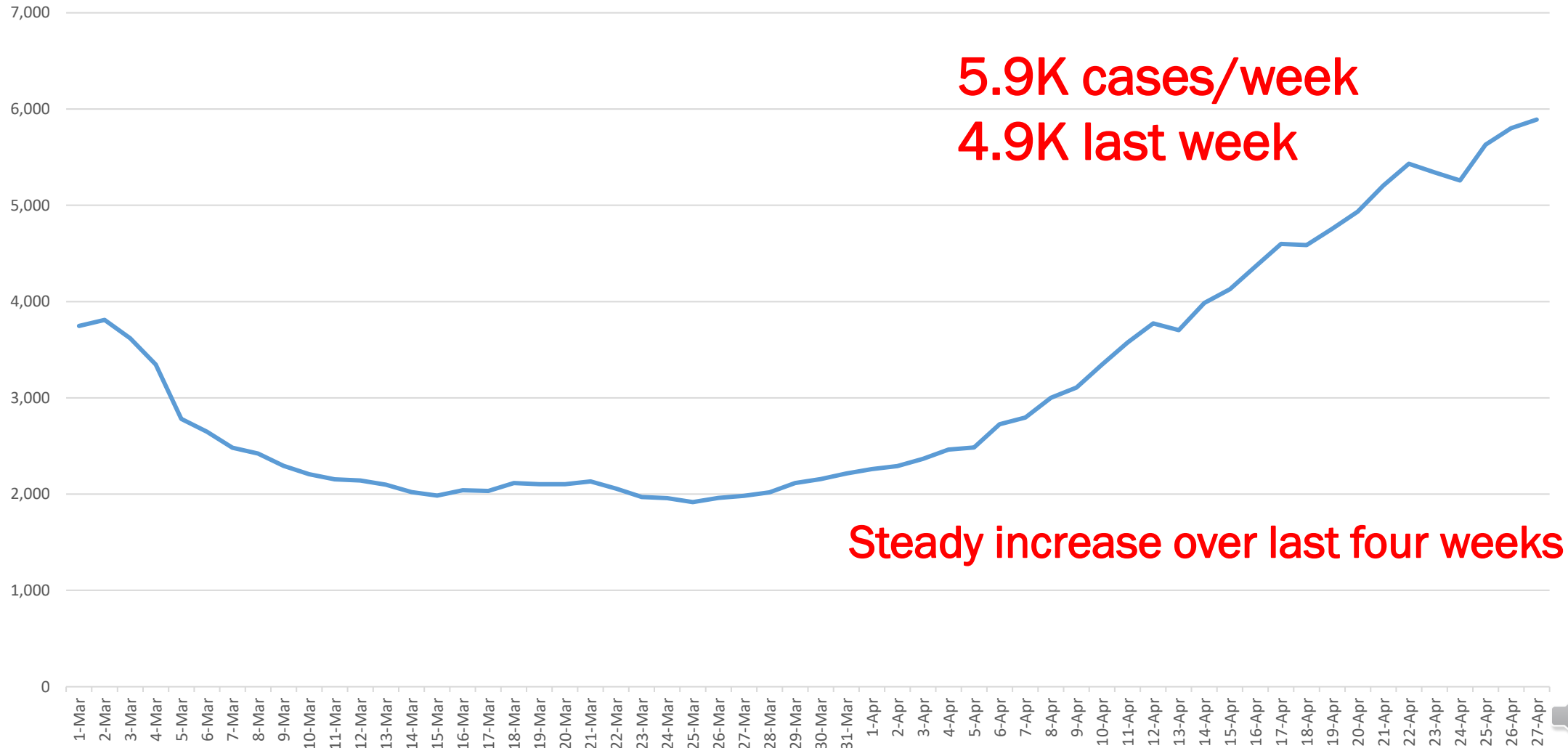

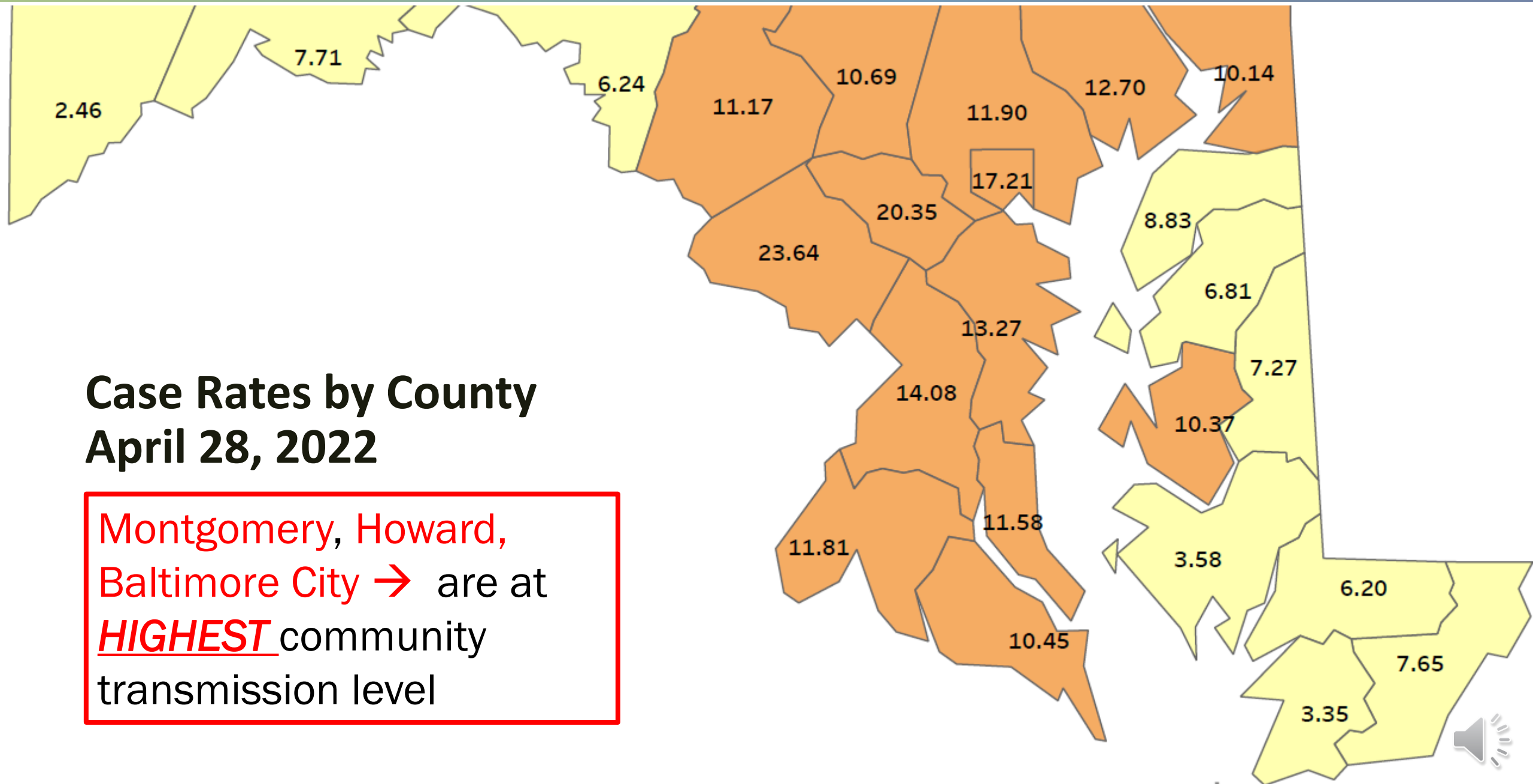


Maryland 7-Day Rolling Average Deaths (Apr 28, 2022)



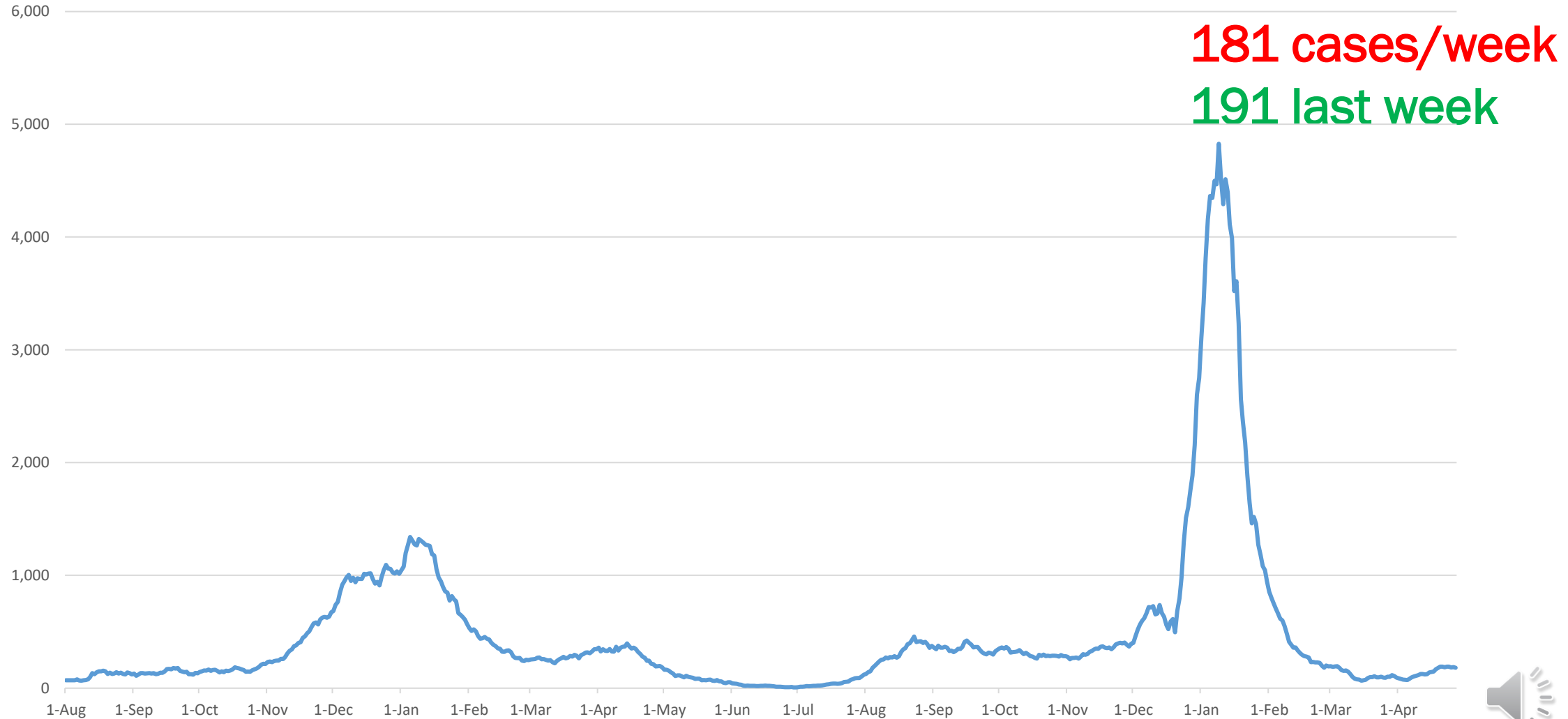
Case Rates by County April 28, 2022

transmission level



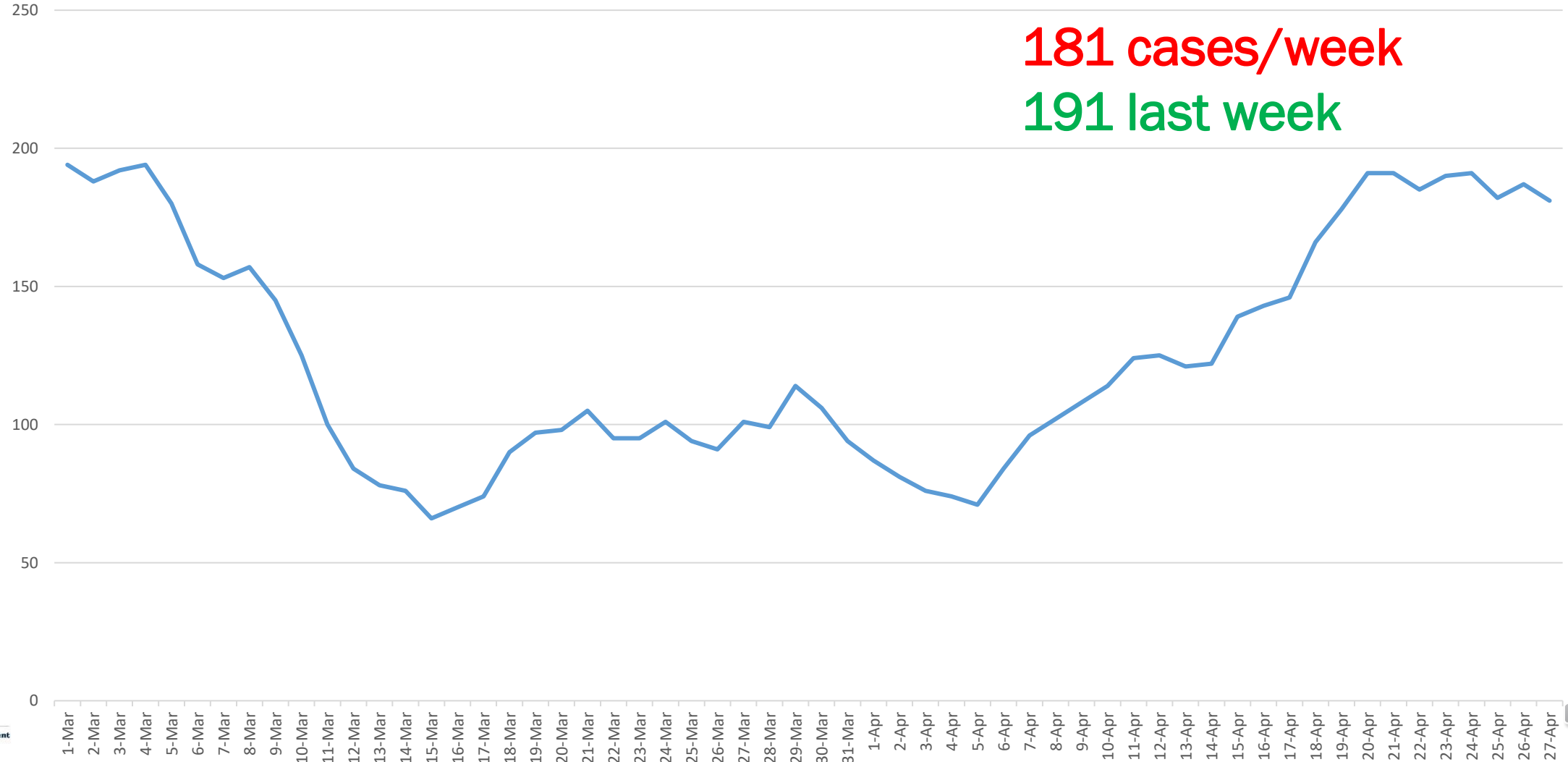
Frederick County 7-Day Rolling Average Cases (Apr 28, 2022)

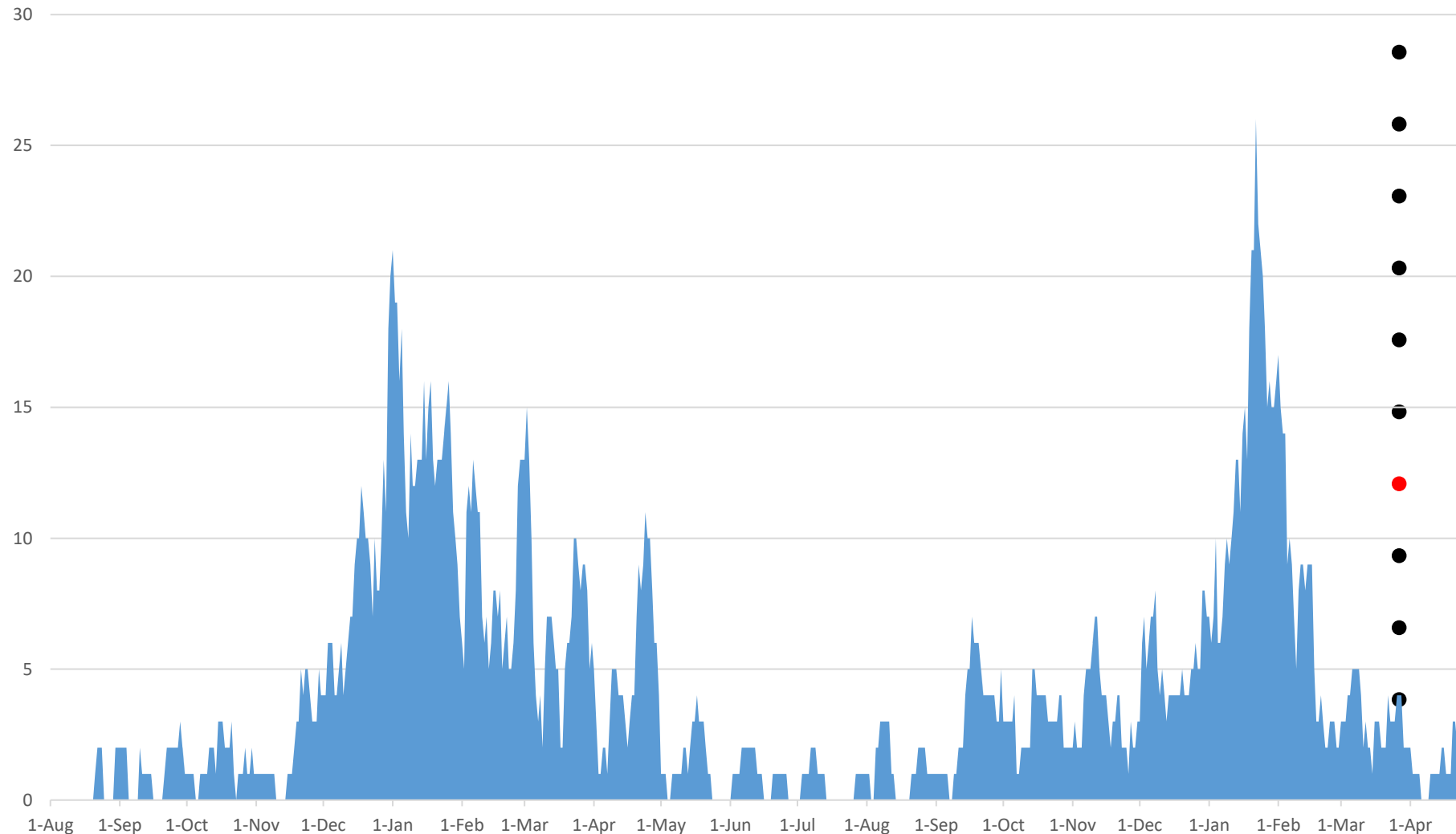

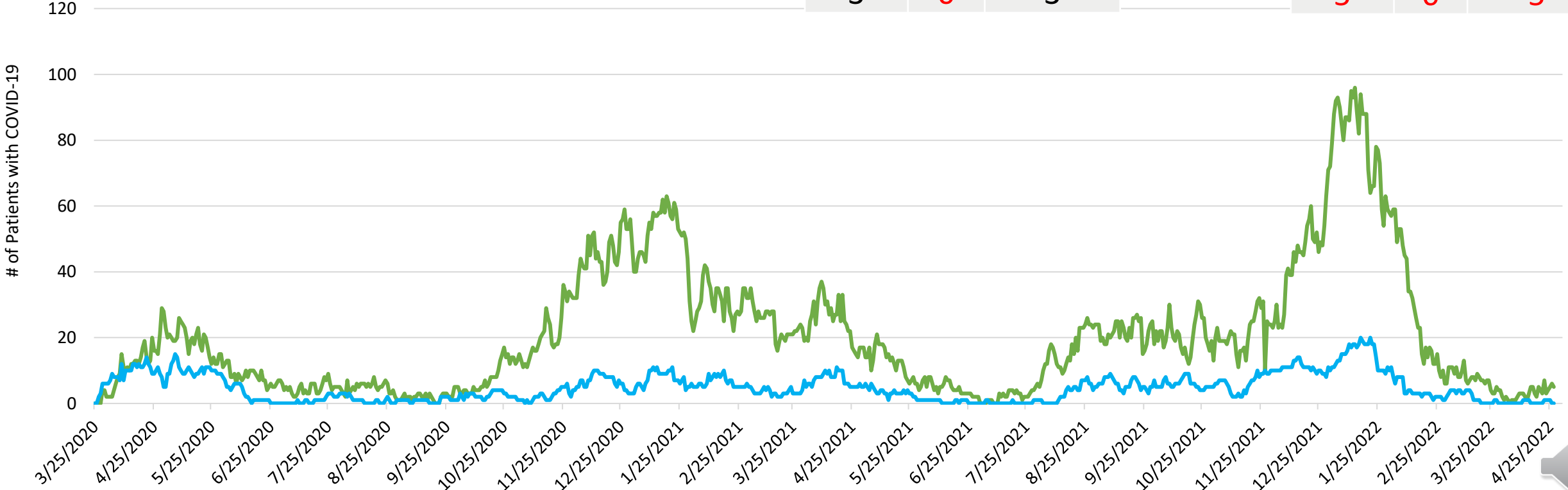
