#### **Frederick County Health Department's Street Safe Program offers the following services:**

- Sterile syringes & other drug use equipment  
*\*\*Now offering smoke kits, snort kits and booty bumping kits\*\**
- Supplies for HRT, PED, and TRT!
- Safe disposal containers & collection of used syringes
- Fentanyl and Xylazine test strips
- Narcan & overdose prevention information
- Rapid HIV and Hepatitis C (HCV) testing
- Telehealth for HCV and Buprenorphine treatment
- Wound care assessment, education & supplies
- Safe sex supplies
- Linkage to care & community supports
- RAD (Rapid Analysis of Drugs) Drug Checking
