Frederick County Board of Health Recruits Liaisons

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Board of Health is now recruiting liaisons to provide their perspectives and expertise to the board. Liaison positions are epidemiologist, nurse, mental health professional, veterinarian, someone with a science-related background, and a member of the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce who is nominated by the Chamber.

Board of Health meetings take place in public and are held a minimum of twice a year. Liaisons are expected to attend these evening meetings in person. Liaisons are volunteer roles: they will have no voting privileges and will not receive any compensation.

“Public health works best when a variety of voices can be included,” said Dr. Barbara Brookmyer, Health Officer for Frederick County and Executive Officer of the Board of Health. “Diversity of backgrounds, lived experiences, education, and perspectives among people on the Board of Health can help us to better reflect our county’s community and ultimately better serve Frederick County.”
