Frederick County Conducts Health Survey To Identify County Residents' Experiences & Concerns

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Health Department, Frederick Health Hospital and the Coalition for a Healthier Frederick County are asking all Frederick County residents to take a short survey about community health issues in Frederick County, Maryland. This online survey is part of the community health needs assessment (CHNA) process. The information shared will be used to identify health priorities and to address these priorities in Frederick County through community action over the next several years.
